

# **LAZERTRAN SILK - HOW DOES IT WORK?**

## **For Silk and Satin**

Just copy any image in reverse or mirror onto the shiny side of a sheet of Lazertran Silk using a Color Photo Copier or toner based Laser Printer. Lay your silk over the image and iron with a hot iron until the Silk sticks to the image.

Place, paper side down, into a bath of warm water and wait about 1 minute until the backing paper falls off.

Lift the silk out carefully and place, image side down, onto a folded cotton sheet. Use a cool iron to gently dry the silk. When completely dry turn the silk over.

Place a sheet of non-stick baking parchment over the image. Iron with a hot iron and allow to cool. Peel off the baking parchment and the job is done.

## **For Polymerclay**

Copy any image in reverse or mirror onto the shiny side of a sheet of Lazertran Silk. Press the image onto the polymer clay making sure you have good contact and leave for about 30 minutes. Pop the clay with the paper attached into a bath of water and leave for 2 minutes. Then 'swish' the water with your hands until the backing paper floats off. Leave to dry and then bake according to clay instructions

## **For Metal Foils**

Iron the image onto the foil using a hot iron. Place immediately in water and soak until backing paper floats off. Allow to dry then run the foil over a hot iron to make sure the toners are attached completely. The foil can now be folded and worked as usual
